Self-Sizing by Default

Link on iOS 11, all estimated heights default to UITableViewAutomaticDimension Headers, footers, and cells use self-sizing by default iOS only—behavior is not changed on tvOS Ensure all views have sufficient internal constraints Return fixed sizes from delegate methods




Table Views and Safe Area

Use UITableViewHeaderFooterView for all headers and footers




